GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

AGPRO LIBERATE is a selective herbicide for use in forestry. This product is absorbed by the roots and foliage. The product works by inhibiting photosynthesis.

WARNING:

This material may be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin.

PRECAUTIONS:

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, dry, well ventilated area out of direct sunlight and away from foodstuffs and drink containers.

Avoid skin contact and inhalation of spray mist.

Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after work.

Triple rinse container and add residue to spray tank. Burn if circumstances especially wind direction permit.

Otherwise bury in landfill.

Avoid contamination of any water supply with chemical or empty container.

HAZARD CLASSIFICATIONS: 6.1E, 6.9B, 9.1A, 9.2A.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed give a glass or two of water to dilute. Do not cause vomiting unless medical treatment is delayed for more than one hour. Take to hospital without delay. If spilt on the skin, remove contaminated clothes and wash affected areas of the skin. DO NOT SCRUB THE SKIN. If concentrate is splashed in the eyes flush with running water for at least 15 minutes. Take to hospital without delay.

MIXING:

Invert container several times before opening. Stir well. Add the full quantity of product to the partly filled spray tank while agitating. Fill tank and agitate to ensure thorough mixing and continue agitation while spraying. Agitate vigorously from the bottom if allowed to stand.

APPLICATION:

AGPRO LIBERATE may be applied through all conventional spray equipment. Do not use strainers finer than 300 micrometres.

PROTECTION OF CROP, NATIVE AND NON-TARGET PLANTS:

When spraying for total weedkilling purposes, care should be taken not to spray beds where desirable annual plants are to be grown. Avoid drift of spray onto garden beds and plants. Do not use in channels or drains or in other situations where roots of desirable plants or shrubs may extend. Do not use near newly planted shrubs, young ornamentals, and other species with surface roots.

BEWARE: APPLY THIS PRODUCT CAREFULLY. SPRAY DRIFT MAY CAUSE SERIOUS DAMAGE TO OTHER DESIRABLE PLANTS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

WEEDS CONTROLLED

AGPRO LIBERATE controls a wide range of weeds including barley grass, black nightshade, brown top, catsear, chickweed, clovers, cocksfoot, doves foot, fathen, Kentucky bluegrass, nodding thistle, poa species, redroot, ryegrass species, Scotch thistle, seedling gorse, shepherds purse, storksbill, sweet vernal, willow weed, Yorkshire fog, Kikuyu, Indian doab, paspalum, Mercer grass, sod-bound couch, cultivated couch, ratstail, prairie grass, soft brome, plus annual grasses and broadleaf weeds.

Add AGPRO Spray Maximiser to the spray mix at the rate of **300ml per 20 litres** of made up spray solution, or at a rate of 3 litres per hectare. Do not add spraying oils.

CROP	RATE	CRITICAL COMMENT
FORESTRY Radiata pine	15-20litres/ha in 200-300 litres of water	Apply prior to spring growth. Use the higher rate for sod bound couch, Mercer grass, browntop, ratstail, Indian doab, kikuyu, paspalum, summer grasses, seedling gorse, or where the vegetation is dense, or where longer residual activity is required.
Knapsack application	1.5-2.0ml/square metre	Apply with sufficient water to obtain good coverage. For spot spraying the normal water rate is 15-20ml per square metre of area.
